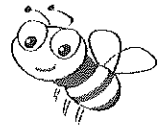

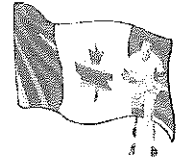


ACCENTUATE THE POSITIVE

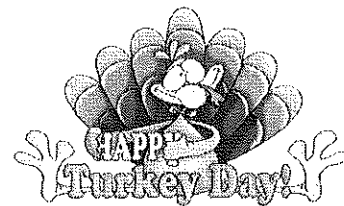
Should you wish to attend a field trip with your child, a current CPIC must be on file at SPS. Please check with Ms. MacGregor that we have a valid CPIC on file.
